


Junkers Ju287

Apparently a full size replica has been constructed of this stealth design, which was 30 years ahead of it's time.







Other items from the AGM, Gary was awarded the Phil Banyard Trophy, colloquially know as the "Strut Screw". Brian Hope fills in the background:-The Phil Banyard Trophy is an interpretation of Da Vinci's proposal for a flying Machine presumably influenced by Archimedes screw. The trophy was made by one of our earliest Strut members. Phil was a mechanical engineer and had worked in the motor trade. He didn't fly but was enthusiastic about aviation and joined the Southern Aviation Society, the

forerunner of the Mid Kent Strut, now the Kent Strut.

Phil donated the trophy in the late nineteen eighties and it became the annual award for those who were considered to have given good service to the running or support of the Strut.

Sadly Phil died about twenty years ago but his trophy serves as a reminder of a much loved past member.
